There are 6 regions across the State
 Each region has its own Local Voice
 Local Voice representatives are elected by the Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander communities in the region
 Representatives are gender diverse



ELECTION DAY



SATURDAY, 16 MARCH 2024

Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islanders enrolled in South Australia vote to elect their Local Voice representatives
 To run as a candidate and to vote you must be enrolled on the electoral roll and be of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander background
